Specialist General Surgeon's Outpatients and Surgeries

Fulltime Ophthalmic Department

The hospital has a full time ophthalmic setup with all the latest equipment. 70-80 patients visit every day for consultation. For patients who are shortlisted for cataract surgery, the eye is measured for Intra Ocular Lens and operated by a specialist eye surgeon. Four sessions

are organized per week, and are done COMPLETELY FREE of cost to the patients.
